

PRIVACY POLICY PURSUANT TO ART. 13 OF EUROPEAN REGULATION 679/2016 (GDPR)

Elektrozubehör S.p.A. (P.I.00729140152) in the person of the legal representative Giorgio Samuele Grun, as Data Controller, informs that the personal data provided by the interested parties will be processed in compliance with European Regulation 679/2016 (so-called GDPR) which regulates and governs the protection of personal data and their free movement.

1) Purpose

The data collected by registering your name or retrieved by us through consultation of public registers, lists or documents that can be accessed by anyone will be processed in compliance with confidentiality obligations. The processing carried out by Elektrozubehör S.p.A. is based on the principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency and the protection of confidentiality and the rights of the data subject. The data shall be used for commercial, promotional and advertising purposes, as well as for management, statistical and possibly profiling purposes. The data shall be recorded, organized and stored in computer and/or paper archives.

1.1) Further Purposes

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate our website (www.elektrozubehor.it) acquire, during their normal operation, certain personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This information is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified. This category of data includes the public IP addresses used by users who connect to the site, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) notation addresses of the resources requested, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the user's operating system and computer environment. The data could also be used to ascertain responsibility in the event of hypothetical computer crimes to the detriment of the site.

2) Data collection characteristics and consequences for a possible non-conferral of the data

The consensus on your personal data is mandatory in order to fulfil the contract, that is to say for the required performance and to comply with the obligations associated, including the legal requirements.

The non-conferral of consent could lead to the impossibility on our behalf to comply with the contractual obligations, namely to the required service.

The consensus of the usage of your data for marketing and/or advertising purposes (sending e-mails and/or communications with advertisement offers) is optional.

3) Timing and deadlines

The proprietor, the person(s) in charge and those authorized (entrusted) by them will process personal data for as long as necessary and to fulfill the above-mentioned purposes and, however, for no more than 10 years from the termination of the contract where required or necessary by current legislation.

4) Data communication and distribution

Your personal data, used for the implementation of the contract and the above-mentioned purposes, can be disclosed:

- to all natural and legal persons (as an example but not limited to consultancy law, management, fiscal and audit firms, couriers and shippers, data-processing centers, suppliers), when it is deemed necessary for the above mentioned purposes.
- to banking institutions for the management of cash receipts and payments.
- to factoring corporations or collection agencies.
- to our staff and employees specifically authorized and within the framework of their tasks.

The DPO, whenever appointed by the proprietor on voluntary or compulsory basis, as well as the name and the number of person(s) in charge can be subject to change, therefore we recommend to visit our website, where you can find all the updated information (www.elektrozubehor.it) or through the following contact details: +39 0270147212, privacy@elektrozubehor.it.

5) Right of withdrawal

By calling the number +39 0270147212 or writing to privacy@elektrozubehor.it you can exercise your rights towards the controller at any time in accordance to European Regulation no 679/2016, written below for your convenience.

The interested party has the right to know whether there is a processing of his personal data underway, even if not already registered, as well as its communication through various means.

The interested party has the right to know:

- the origin of personal data (particularly when the data are not collected by the interested party and, when transferring data to a third country, about the existence of adequate guarantees pursuant to art. 46 of the Regulation).
- the mode and purpose of the treatment.
- the logic applied when data-processing is done through electronic means.
- the contact details of the proprietor, the person(s) in charge and the appointed representative.
- the subjects of categories of subjects to whom personal data can be notified or that can be acknowledged, as designated territorial representative of the State, persons in charge or authorized subjects.
- the categories of personal data you are processing.
- the period of data storage or the criteria used to determine this period.
- the existence of automated decision- making processes, in particular with regard to profiling and the underlying logic.
- the right of acquiring a copy of the personal data processed.

Furthermore, the interested party has the right to obtain:

- the update, the correction, that is to say, when requested, the integration of the data.
- the cancellation, the conversion in anonymous form or the block of the data that are in violation of the law, including
 those whose storage is not necessary, in relation to the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently
 processed.
- the attestation that the operations described above have been notified, including with regard to their content, to those whom have received the data, except for when this fulfilment is impossible or requires disproportionate means compared to the right protected.
- data portability towards other parties for whom there must be an explicit written request (call +39 0270147212 or write to privacy@elektrozubehor.it).
- data cancellation from our archives according to art. 17 pt. 1 from point a) to f) of the Regulation (e.g. right to be forgotten), by contacting +39 0270147212 or privacy@elektrozubehor.it.
- to restrict the data processing according to art.18, paragraph 1, from point a) to d) of the Regulation.

The interested party has the right to oppose, in whole or in part, to the processing of the data:

- for legitimate reasons connected to his/her particular situation, although the processing is relevant to the purpose of data collection.
- to the processing of personal data related to sending advertising material or direct sale or market researches or business communication.
- to the processing of data according to art. 6, paragraph 1, point e) to f) including profiling on the basis of those provisions.

Whenever data processing is based on the consent of the subject, he has the right to withdraw that consent at any time by making a simple request to $+39\ 0270147212$ or privacy@elektrozubehor.it.

The interested party, moreover, has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.

The application of the above-mentioned rights can be exercised by a request addressed by telephone or e-mail to the above mentioned addresses or by registered letter or certified mail.
